Economics for Success Grades 8-10

Students discover how their interests and strengths connect to future careers, explore post-secondary options and learn budgeting skills.

JA Company Program Grades 9-12

18 week program where Students co-create and operate a small business as they gain experience with each step of the business cycle.

Our Business World Grades 8-10

Students learn what a business is, how businesses make a profit, how they benefit communities, why they evolve over time and explore what it means to be an entrepreneur.

Steps to Volunteering With JA New Brunswick

1. Contact the local Programs and Community Partners Manager
2. Complete the mandatory Vulnerable Sector Check (VSC) where applicable.
3. Attend volunteer training (1 hr. virtual session)
4. Communicate with JA and the teacher (~ 30 mins)
5. Facilitate the program (time commitment pending role above)
