Program Length: 2-7 hours

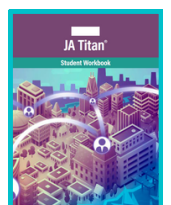
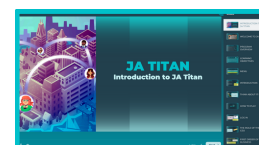
Program Format: In-Class

What will students do and learn?

- Set and manage a company budget using limited cash-on-hand

- Select product features to develop through R&D
- Use market research and advertising to target customer demographics
- Analyze reports to improve profit, profit margin, and market share
- Adjust strategies based on results and competitive conditions
